



Pictograms





The Colours of meteoblue

The meteoblue brand colours form the foundation of the brand's visual identity, fostering a strong emotional connection with our audience. They ensure consistency across all communication materials.

This chapter defines the primary colours used for main branding, as well as secondary colours that support and accentuate designs. Exact colour codes (HEX, RGB, CMYK) are provided to maintain consistency across digital and print media.

The provided lighter and darker variations of the meteoblue blue, as well as gradients between these variations, are permissible. The same applies to the highlight colour. However, gradients between meteoblue blue and the highlight colour are not permitted.
